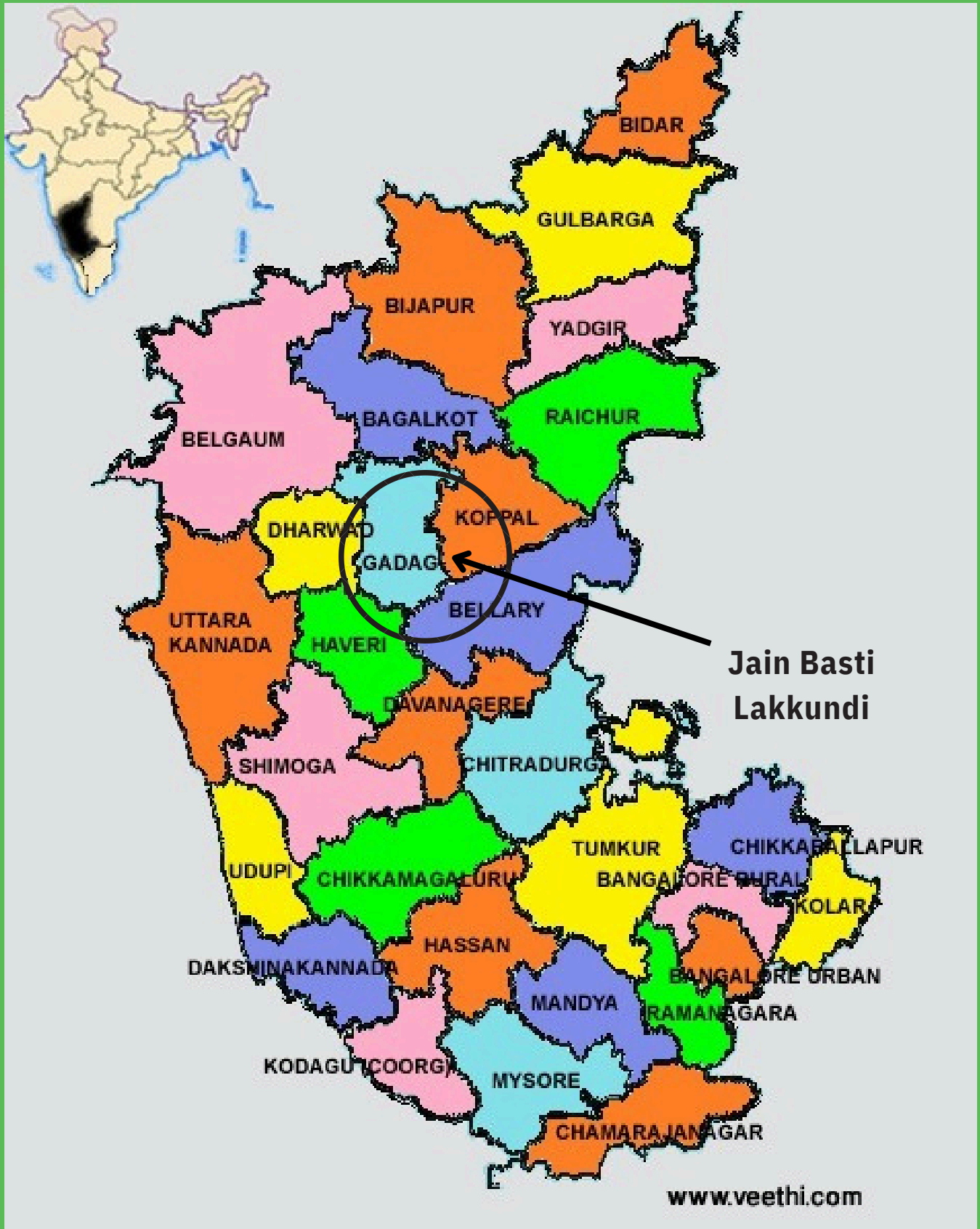


Monuments of Karnataka under Dharwad Circle

Brief history of the monument:

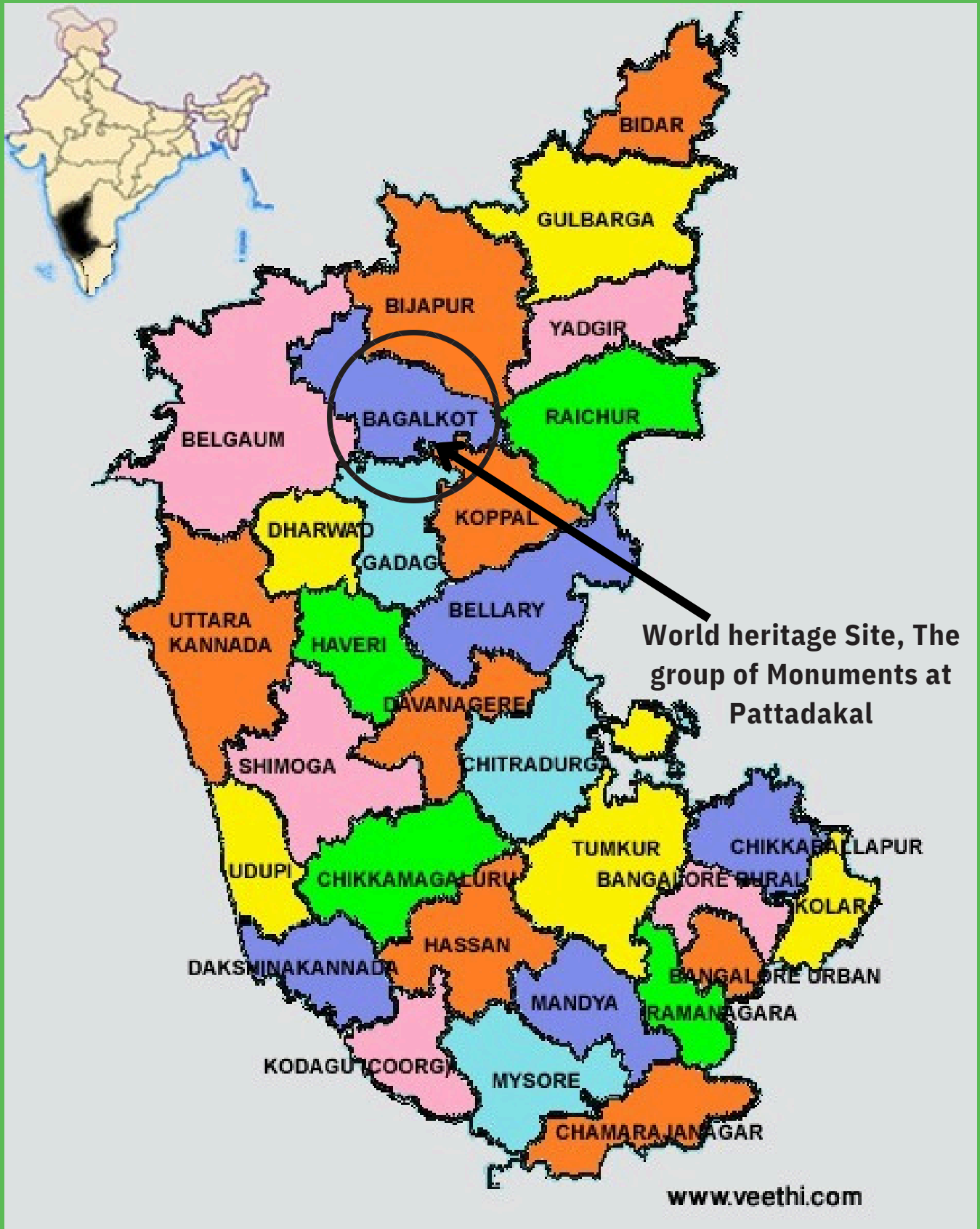
This 11th century CE, temple facing east is the largest and the most prominent temple at Lakkundi. The temple has a garbhagriha, antarala, a closed navaranga, and an open pillared mandapa with a roof sloopy on sides and front.



- Up gradation of sculpture shade into Interpretation Centre,
- including change of display panels, installation digital panel, creation of Children gallery

Estimated cost of the proposed work is Rs. 200 lakh

World heritage Site, The group of Monuments at Pattadakal, Badami taluk, Bagalkot district

Brief history of the monument:

World Heritage Property, Pattadakal, in Karnataka, represents the high point of an eclectic art which, in the 7th and 8th Centuries under the Chalukya dynasty. The oldest temple at Pattadakal is Sangamesvara built by Vijayaditya Satyasraya (697-733 CE).



- In the year 2019, due to devastating flood compound wall of WHP Group of monuments at Pattadakal collapsed.
 - Revival of Boundary wall at the Group of monuments at Pattadakal.
- Illumination (including façade lighting) to WHP The group of Monuments at Pattadakal

Estimated cost of the proposed work is Rs. 800 lakh
