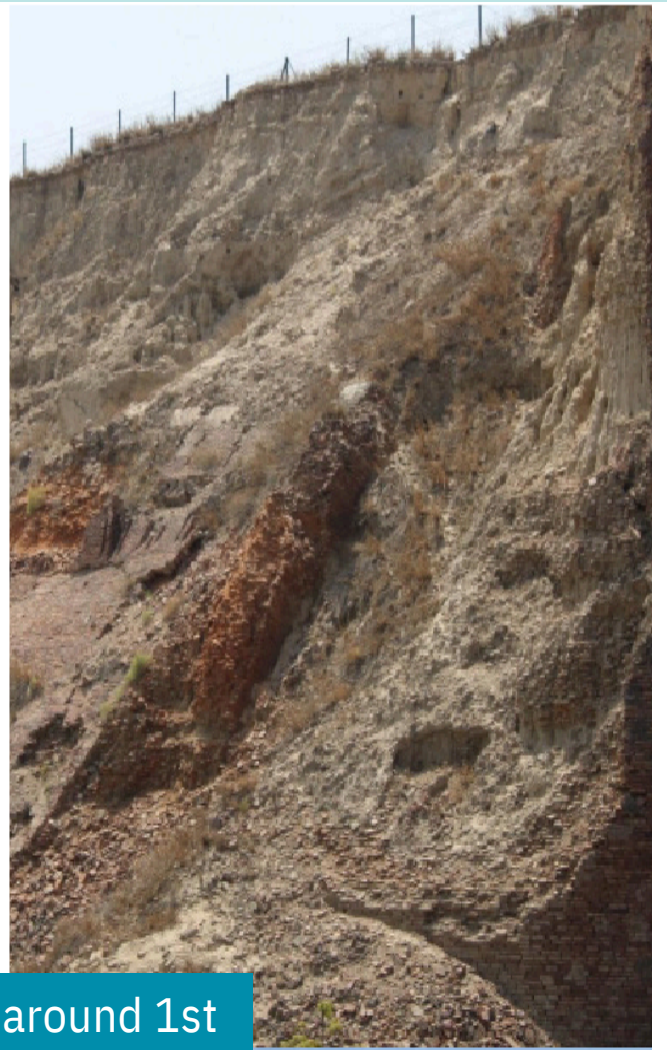


Monument of Punjab under Chandigarh Circle





It was built around 1st century AD





Bathinda Fort, Dist. Bathinda

Area of the Monument- 15 acres approx.

Brief history of the monument:

It was built around 1st century AD. Raja the female Sultan was kept as a prisoner in the fort by Altunia. There are 32 small and 4 large bastions. A Gurudwara dedicated to Guru Gobind Singh built by Maharaja Karam Singh of Patiala.



PROPOSED WORK:

- a) Restoration of bastions no. 1 to 10 and 33-34 of Bathinda Fort.
- b) Removal of fallen debris/Malba carefully including sorting of serviceable material and disposal of unserviceable material.
- c) Taking out bulged/missing brick work in bastion no. 1 to 10, 33, and 34.
- d) Providing Lakhori Bricks masonry in missing portions of bastions and walls in lime surkhi mortar.
- e) Providing recessed pointing in lime surkhi mortar including racking of joints complete in lime surkhi mortar.
- f) Providing back filling in bastions and wall behind brick masonry wherever necessary with appropriate material.

Estimated cost of the proposed work is Rs. 2000 lakh
