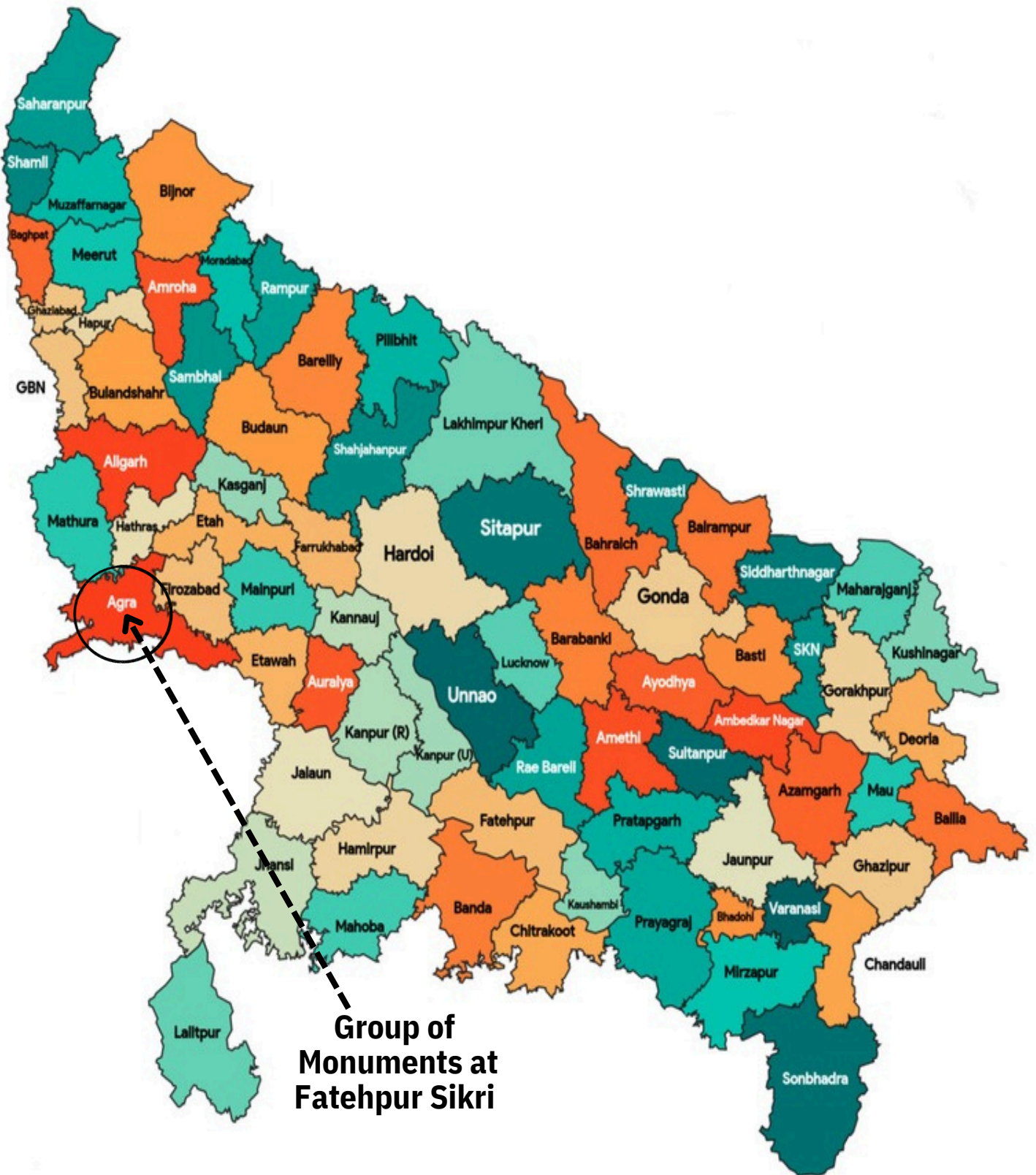


Monuments of Uttar Pradesh under Agra Circle







Group of Monuments at Fatehpur Sikri, Agra, Dist. Agra

Brief history of the monument:

The medieval city of Fatehpur Sikri (Long: 27° 05'38" N; Lat: 77° 42'17" E) is situated on an extension of the upper Vindhyan ranges, in the environs of now dried up natural lake. Though, Fatehpur Sikri is popularly known as the Capital city of Mughals established by Akbar, it has a long cultural history prior to it. Archaeological explorations of the region have revealed pre historic stone tools, rock shelters with paintings on the periphery of the lake

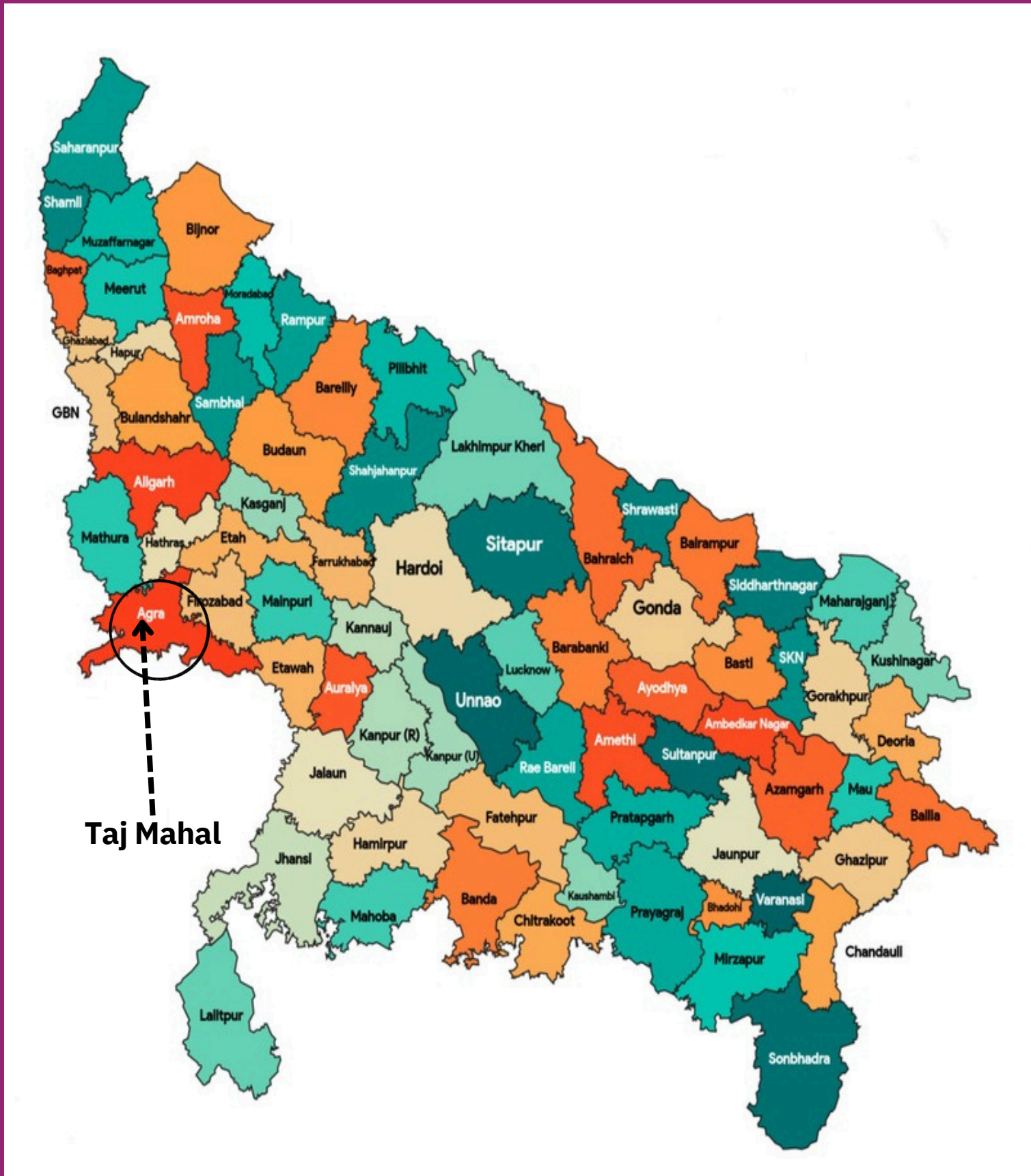


PROPOSED WORK:

- Provision of public amenities at three different location to meet out the visitor requirements. The provision will include toilets, washroom, drinking water facilities, baby feeding rooms and a dedicated space for disabled and senior citizens.
- Provision for construction of new museum building and display along with provision of storage of archival record, library, study center and A.V. hall/conference hall at Khasra No. 244/2.

Taj Mahal, Agra, District: Agra

Brief history of the monument:

The Taj Mahal (Long: 27° 10'27" N; Lat: 78° 02'34" E), aptly described as dream in white marble, is a masterpiece of Indo-Islamic architecture. It represents the remarkable engineering skill and perfection of construction devices as well as aesthetic ideals of the period. The monument was built by the Mughal emperor Shah Jahan (reigned 1628-58 A.D.) on the right bank of the river Jamuna as a garden tomb for his most favourite queen Mumtaz Mahal following her death in 1631 A.D.



PROPOSED WORK:

- Provision of Shoe Covers at Main Mausoleum, Taj Mahal, Agra.
- Cleaning and maintenance of public amenities Setting up of interpretation center.

Estimated cost of the proposed work is Rs. 450 lakh
