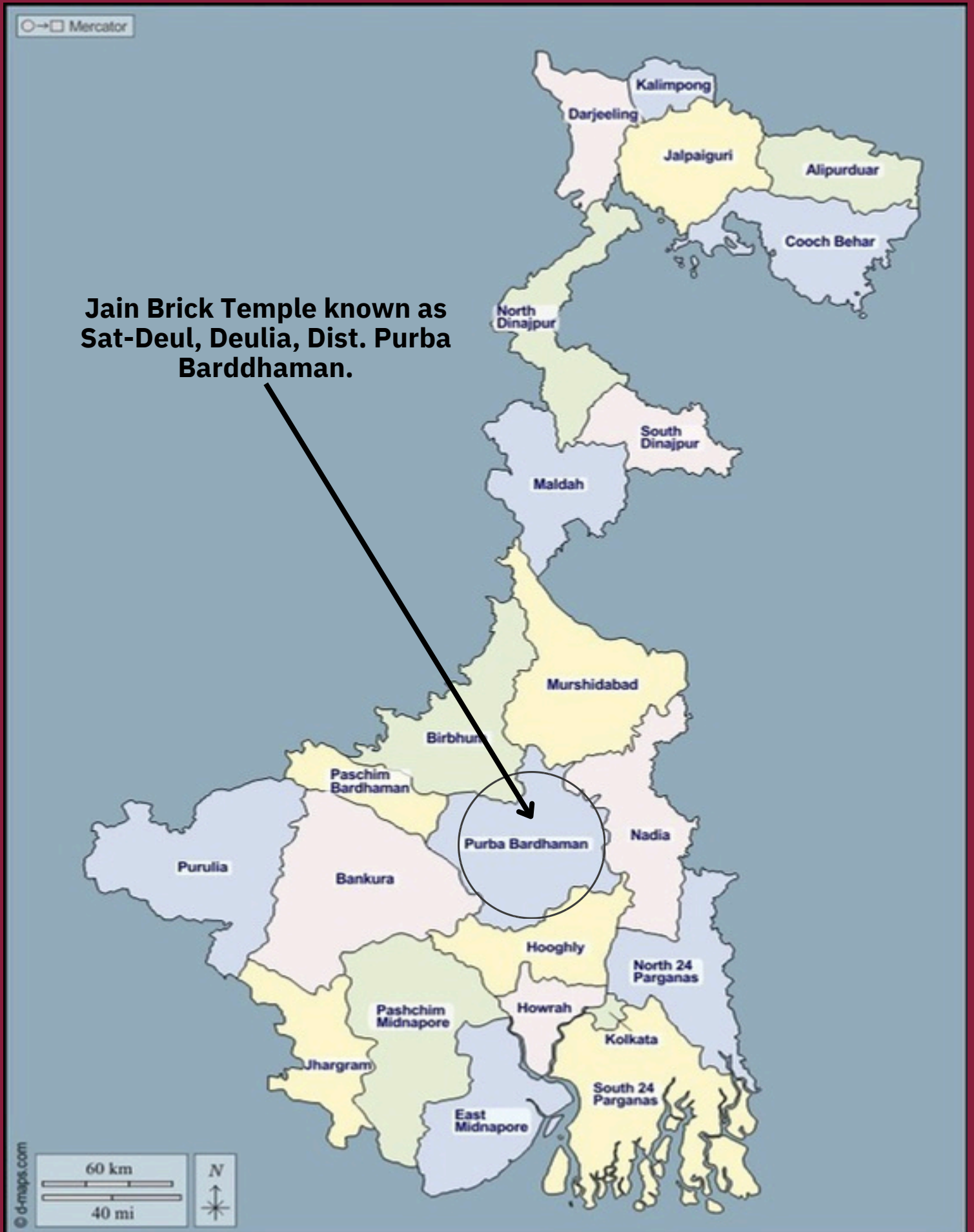


Monuments of West Bengal under Kolkata Circle

This deserted brick temple seems to be one of the oldest brick temples in Bengal. It appears to have once enshrined a Jaina divinity which was discovered at the site now kept in the sanctum

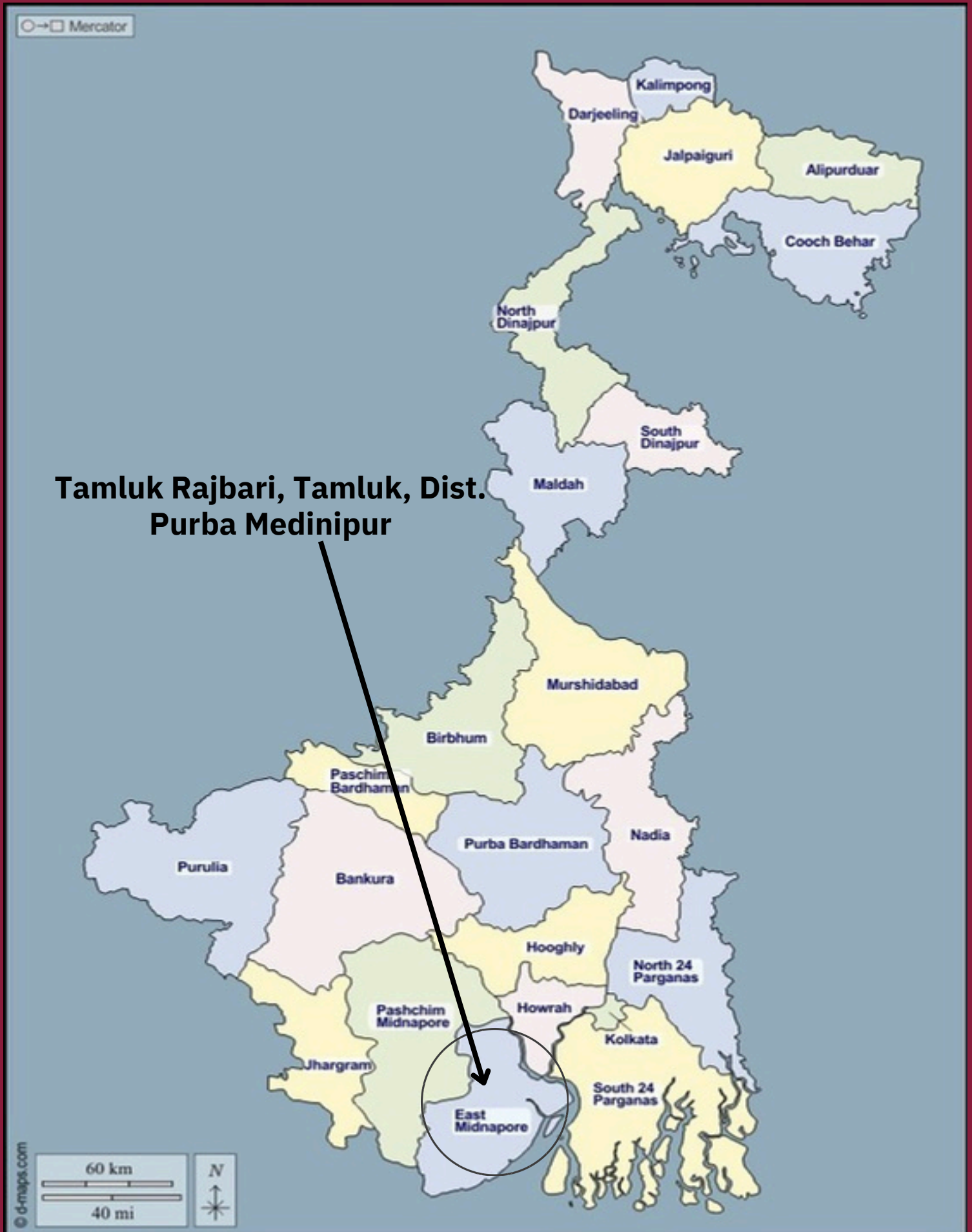
PROPOSED WORK:

Brief history of the monument:

The Rajbari complex is situated in the suburban area of Tamluk town of sub-division and district Purba Midnapur. The town is well connected by road and rails transport. The river Rupnaryan is the joint flow of the river Darkeshwar and the river Shilai which is finally discharge its water to the river Bhagirathi about 16 km south-east of Tamluk



PROPOSED WORK:

Conservation of Main Rajbari Complex exposing of buried structures removal of debris etc.

Public amenities, toilet block, benches, signages and drinking etc.

Pathways land scaping, gardening of the monuments

Estimated cost of the proposed work is Rs. 300 lakh
