Multilateral MOU signed for raising the 120 feet tall Flag Post at Rashtrapati Nilayam, Telangana.

A multilateral Memorandum of Understanding has been signed between The President's Secretariat, Rashtraprati Bhavan (PS-RB), India Infrastructure Finance Company Limited (IIFCL), National Culture Fund (NCF), Archaeological Survey Of India (ASI) AND National Building Construction Corporation India Limited(NBCC-I Ltd) on 19th September, 2023 for raising the 120 feet tall Flag Post at Rashtrapati Nilayam, Telangana.

The Flag Post replica, the historical structure of importance located in Rashtrapati Nilaya, Secunderabad will become an attractive destination of historical and cultural importance

IIFCL under their CSR in consultation with ASI-NCF-NBCC agreed to contribute a sum of Rs. 2.75 crore for the project.

ASI will be in charge of the works relating for "Planning, designing and raising of replica of 120 feet high wooden flag post along with civil, lighting, illumination and Landscape cum horticulture work at Rashtrapati Nilayam".

The project will be completed by 10th December,2023 and shall be monitored by a Project Implementation Committee which will have the representatives of all the parties herein.

The flag post will be installed in wood pattern which will have a life span of 200 to 250 years.

Central Building Research Institute, Roorkee will provide design and consultancy for the structure stability.
